

### Iowa's Rank in Number of Physicians per Population

The following table shows the number of individuals per one physician in the state of Iowa and a ranking of Iowa's numbers in comparison with other states and the District of Columbia. Report data was developed based on 2007 U.S. Census estimated population figures and 2007 numbers of physicians (allopathic and osteopathic) providing direct patient care in self-designated specialties taken from *Physician Characteristics and Distribution in the U.S., 2009 Edition*, Division of Survey and Data Resources, American Medical Association, 2009. Note that a ranking of "1" is the most favorable and "51" is the least favorable.
